





History of The Bishopbriggs Golf Club

In 1906 a group of golf enthusiasts leased 53 hectares of land in the Kenmure area of Bishopbriggs, lying within the boundaries of the original 'Kenmure Estate'. The group commissioned renowned golf course architect James Braid to design a number of the holes, and the course was opened in 1907 with 9-holes, and extended to 18-holes in 1911.

In case the golf course was not a success, the Clubhouse was built in the style of a family home, so that they could then recoup their investment by selling the 'house'. Fortunately by the 1920's and 30's, the club was very successful and popular with local residents.

Until 1930, sheep grazed the course and the greens were cut by hand, with the help of horse-drawn cutters used to keep the rough in check.

The Members purchased the lease in 1991, and significant investment has since been made to enhance many areas of the golf course and its surroundings. A new Golf Academy was established with nine mini holes, six driving bays, and two practice greens.

The modern course measures 6,262 yards of parkland, with tree-lined fairways and excellent greens, along with views of the Campsie Fells which are second-to-none.
